





#### **ASKING SMARTER QUESTIONS**





Is this school good or bad?



**Instead of:** 

What's the right college?



**Instead of:** 

What's the best college?



#### Try this:

Is this school good for me? What are its strengths?



#### Try this:

What are my priorities and where will I be successful?



#### Try this:

What's the best college for me? Where can I thrive?

#### HOW MAJOR IS MY MAJOR?



#### **SELECTED**

#### **MAJORS**

The admissions process and requirements can vary by major.

#### REMEMBER:

Some school acceptance rates can also be drastically different depending on the major.

#### **CONSIDER**

- 1. How competitive is this particular program?
- 2. How do you as an applicant fit in this specific applicant pool?
- 3. How much does a potential career drive your decision?


## Step #2

#### **Window Shopping**

#### **Full Price Item**

Determine the college costs, financial aid offerings, etc.

You don't need to spend money on college visits to see them. Students can gain valuable insight without getting on a plane!

Be mindful of college rankings websites. The one thing these rankings don't consider is **YOU** and how this college best fits your needs, wants, and interests!




