National Collegiate Retention and Persistenceto-Degree Rates, 2018

Since 1983, ACT has collected a comprehensive database of first-to-second-year retention rates and persistence-to-degree rates. These rates provide national benchmarks for institution type and level of selectivity. Data are compiled by ACT from the ACT Institutional Data Questionnaire, an annual online survey of information collected from two-year and four-year postsecondary institutions.

- Retention rate: Percent of first-time/full-time students who first enrolled in fall 2016 and were also enrolled in fall 2017 at the same institution.
- Persistence-to-degree rate: Percent of students completing a
 degree within a designated time frame at the same institution.
 The tables in this document are based on the year in which a
 particular cohort enrolled as first-time/full-time degree-seeking
 students, as illustrated below.
